Additionally, please be reminded of the following policies:

COVID-19 Health & Safety Protocol

- Studio floors are marked in 6' increments to maintain social distancing.
- Faculty, staff and students are required to wear a mask that safely covers the nose and mouth. Breaks will be given as needed.
- A safety shield has been placed at the front desk for safe transactions. Automatic billing will also ensure contactless transactions.
- Contact-free soap dispensers, paper towels and hand sanitizer dispensers are available.
- Dancers are asked to please enter the studio using our main entrance and will exit using our back door.
- Our waiting area is temporarily closed to parents/guardians of dancers in and above Elementary level classes. One parent/guardian may accompany younger dancers; however, please no siblings.
- The studio ventilation has been updated to include a hepafiltration system to improve the airflow circulation.
- 15-minute buffer periods are scheduled between all classes to allow for proper sanitizing and disinfecting.
- Dancers are asked to arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to his or her class time.
- A daily deep clean of the entire facility will be performed to ensure maximum safety.
- If your dancer(s) are not feeling well, please keep him or her home until he or she is feeling better.

General Rules & Regulations

- Dress codes will be strictly enforced, since it is part of the discipline of dance and ensures that your child will get the proper dance training. Please refer to the website for dress code requirements per class.
- Warm-up dancewear may be worn at the teacher's discretion.
- No dangling jewelry is to be worn to class. Not only is it a distraction, but it can be lost.
- No cell phones allowed in dance studios.
- Gum chewing is not allowed during class.
- No food or drinks in the studios. Water bottles only will be allowed. Please remember to clean up.

Tuition*

Payment Schedule

- Tuition is based on a 9-month calendar year from September through May.
- Tuition payments are due on the 1st of every month.
- **Auto-Pay (Reoccurring Billing)**
Each family must keep a credit card or checking/saving account (ACH) on file. Your tuition will be deducted from your account on the first of the month. Reoccurring payments can be made by Visa, Mastercard, Discover or checking/savings account
- All tuition and costume balances **must be paid in full** in order to participate in our annual recital.

Late Fees

- A **Late Fee of \$15** will be charged for payments that are not able to be processed by the 10th of the month.
- There are NO REFUNDS for missed classes.
- Missed classes, however, may be made-up within a month of the absence.

School Schedule and Inclement Weather

- Classes are not necessarily cancelled when school is cancelled.
- During inclement weather, we highly recommend calling the studio 1 hour prior to your scheduled class to see if your class is cancelled.
- Since this is not a weekly tuition, the rates are not adjusted from class cancelled due to holidays, inclement weather or other uncontrollable circumstances. (Likewise, there is no extra charge for months that have 5 classes.)
